THE NEED

Right business opportunity is the key to enterprise success. Most small industry entrepreneurs falter in sensing and identifying appropriate business opportunities; they set up the project without properly scanning the total economic environment.

Opportunity sensing is essential for new as well as existing entrepreneurs; once existing entrepreneurs reach the comfort stage in their project, new business opportunities need to be identified for enterprise sustenance, growth and development. In the present era of liberalization and globalisation, competition is increasingly intensifying. Growth opportunities abound for expansion, diversification or modernization, and for this entrepreneur needs to scan the emerging environment before finalizing the most optimal opportunity that maximizes gains from limited investment and resources.

Experience and also our latest countrywide research indicates most SSI entrepreneurs do not possess the right opportunity sensing skills and in the process commit costly and irreparable mistakes. The five-day training programme being organized by NIESBUD aims at equipping trainer-promoters of entrepreneurs as well as new/existing entrepreneurs with skills, tools and techniques necessary for sensing the right business opportunity that provides maximum profits and business opportunity for long-term sustenance/growth.

OBJECTIVES

1. To develop understanding of the emerging business environment for identifying business opportunities, particularly SME;
2. To familiarize participant with tools and techniques for sensing the right opportunities.
3. To provide necessary skills for evaluating opportunities perceived in the newly liberalized and global environment.
4. To create personal experiences for sensing business opportunities in the day to day working of the industrial/business enterprise.
5. To generate appreciation of the scope and use of knowledge necessary for opportunity sensing so as to ensure healthy industrial growth.

METHODOLOGY

Discussions and interface with technology experts to facilitate experiential learning. Case method and simulation exercises are extensively employed to enable participants practically understand the entire process of SSI Project Identification and Selection.

COURSE FEE

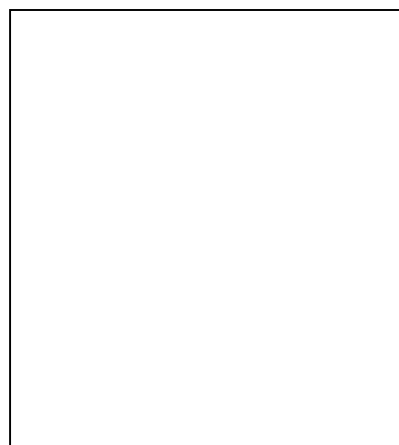
