New Delhi: The National Institute of Entrepreneurship and Small Business Development (NIESBUD), a premier Institute under the Ministry of MSME has decided to launch a major project for entrepreneurship and skill development of youth in the country.

The project would be launched by December 2011 in the states of West Bengal, Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Haryana, Delhi, Rajasthan, Orissa, Bihar, Jharkhand, Chattisgarh, Punjab, J&K, Gujarat and Union Territory of Chandigarh.

With the launch of this project, NIESBUD will target 35,000 youths.
